- Running Vista – **DUN-PCS Vision** connection prompts user to Set Network Location for each connection session.
 - Remedy – Select **Tools**→**Options**→ scroll down to **NDIS Support** (Enable NIC for Data Connection)→**Yes**→**OK** – Wait for modem to reset - Confirm **WWAN-PCS Vision** displayed
 - User will be prompted to Set Network Location for the first connection session only
- Installations have been seen to take up to 17 minutes to complete
