# **Installation and Configuration Instructions**

# **Important BIOS Installation Information**

- This BIOS update contains an EC update. To activate the EC change you must remove AC after the installation completes (shut down).
- This BIOS update will reset the BIOS configuration settings. After the installation is complete you will need to reapply any non-default BIOS configuration settings. The BIOS password will be preserved during the installation process.

#### To install the BIOS update:

- 1. Download the BIOS update to the directory location of your choice.
- 2. Unzip the file to a location on your local drive.
- 3. Double-click installer and follow the prompts.
  - Note: Ensure the tablet is using AC power before opening the file.
- 4. The update process may take some time. Do not manually power-off the tablet during the update.
- 5. The tablet will automatically shut down after installing the BIOS.
